



Construction Site Supervisor

Working in coordination with the Construction Manager the Site Supervisor has ultimate responsibility for day-to-day construction activities on Teton Habitat's affordable housing projects. Our next project will be constructing 18 townhomes phased over four years starting this spring.

This position includes a competitive hourly wage, full health benefits including vision and dental, generous time off, a retirement plan, and bonus structure.

Primary responsibilities of this position are:

- Overall supervision of current and pending construction activities,
- Guiding and assigning daily construction tasks to Habitat team members and volunteers •
- Enforce safety measures in accordance with industry-recognized best practices •
- Coordination with construction manager for take-off, procurement & receipt of materials •
- Preparation/coordination to receive volunteers on-site
- Preparation/coordination to receive sub-contractors on-site
- Adhere to construction timelines to ensure efficient and successful completion of projects on or ahead of schedule.

Other duties include:

- Participate in volunteer activities & construction tasks on volunteer days
- Monitor site compliance with approved safety protocols
- Maintain site organization and orderliness
- Prepare for each work day with appropriately sized crews, tools and materials •
- Coordinate billing cost codes with construction manager
- Participation in regular staff and construction committee meetings
- Maintain mid-term job schedules (5-week schedule)
- Maintain construction standards in accordance with industry-approved protocols •
- maintain current Competent Person safety qualifications.

The ideal candidate will have:

Two years of construction experience; a clear understanding of the mission of Habitat for Humanity; a demonstrated ability to manage a construction team; an interest and willingness to instruct volunteers in relevant aspects of the construction trade; an ability to adapt, problem-solve and trouble-shoot.
